The honourable supreme court of India has

given a comprehensive meaning of ragging as –

"Ragging is any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing treating or handling with rudeness and students including in rowdy or indiciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension therefore in a fresher or a junior students and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior students "

In simple words it involves in sults (direct or suggestive sexual or sarcastic) , running errands for senior and any kind of bullying or activities that are demeaning to the new entrants .

Ragging is strictly prohibited in Govt. Nagrik Kalyan Mahavidhyalya Nandini Nagar Ahiwara Durg , disciplinary action will be taken against any such acts. Depanding upon the nature and gravity of the offense possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following cancellation of admission, suspension from attending classes and debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evalution process.
